



## Auberge Saint-Antoine sustainability policy

The Auberge Saint-Antoine is committed to taking concrete action and continuing to improve our ecological practices to come as close as possible to "zero impact", both in terms of the management of our natural resources and through our local partnerships, as well as by promoting responsible behavior among our customers and colleagues.

To meet this commitment, the entire Auberge Saint-Antoine team strives to:

- Support local businesses and actors, notably through reasoned sourcing;
- Maintain biodiversity through organic farming and the use of beehives;
- Preserve local culture and heritage during construction and renovation;
- Manage the use of lighting and water on the property and at the farm;
- Maintain and check installations and equipment regularly;
- Opt only for water- and energy-efficient appliances in future purchases;
- Maintain a sustainable sorting policy: treatment of wastewater and grease, composting, provision of sorting garbage cans clearly identified by customers and colleagues;
- Monitor waste quantities and reduce them, in particular by limiting individual and disposable packaging;
- Respect all relevant environmental and social legislation;
- Ban the use of pesticides and chemical fertilizers, and secure the disposal of high-risk products;
- Establish a purchasing policy favoring sustainable products and inform our partners of our commitments;
- Train and inform our colleagues and customers about our environmental practices and how they can contribute to them. For example, by using sustainable transport;
- Inform our customers about the carbon footprint of their trip and how they can contribute.

- Monitor our environmental performance and adjust our actions accordingly;
- Ensure respect for animal welfare by offering vegetarian options, banning the purchase of products from endangered species, and prohibiting shows involving animals.

Auberge Saint-Antoine will meet its sustainability commitments while maintaining the highest standards of service for our customers. The policy is evaluated annually by a committee led by Louise Melen, Sustainability Officer and Communications, Marketing and Public Relations Coordinator.
