Take a trip to what feels like a historic European city without the long flight and jet lag. Visitors can stroll through the narrow cobblestoned streets by foot or on a horse-drawn carriage to admire the city's famous French-colonial architecture and historic sites such as the Citadel, the Petit-Champlain District, Place Royale, Parliament Building, and fortifications dating back to the 1600's. The Old City is also a hub for art and cuisine, with a selection of museums and fine dining restaurants. Also visit lle d'Orleans just across the St. Lawrence River for a wine tasting and picnic lunch while overlooking the Montmorency Falls.
